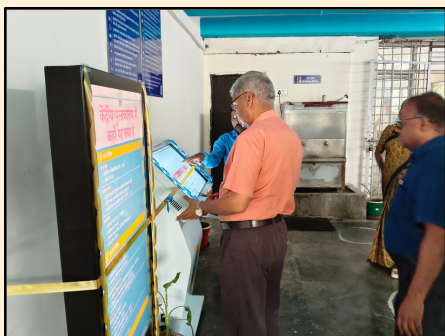

Article Processing Charges Support by ONOS



Article Publishing Charges/Article Processing Charges (APC) is one of the components of the ONOS scheme. APCs for selected good-quality open-access journals will be centrally funded through the executing agency for ONOS. As decided by the Core Committee, ONOS, fully open access journals which are in the top 1% as per any of the 3 indicators: CiteScore, SNIP or SJR published by SCOPUS are eligible for payment of APC from ONOS. The open access journals can be either from the 30 publishers providing access to their published journals in ONOS or other publishers. More details available [here](#).

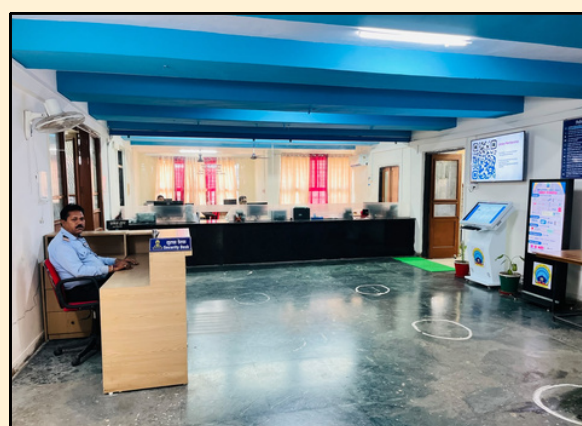
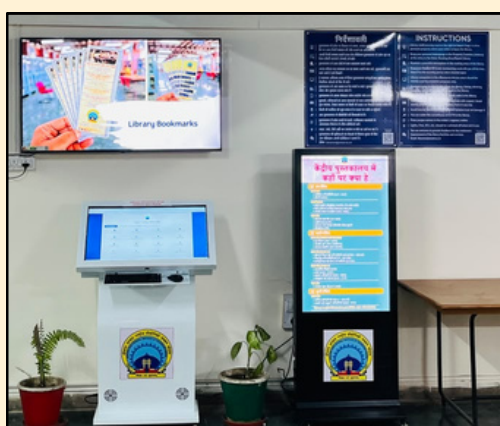
ACM, the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM Digital Library), is subscribed under the Read-and-Publish Agreement under ONOS. This agreement provides 6,500 government-funded higher education and research institutions across India with Premium Access to the ACM Digital Library, while enabling authors in participating institutions to publish an unlimited number of Open Access research articles in ACM journals, ACM conference proceedings and ICPS Proceedings with no article processing charges (APCs). 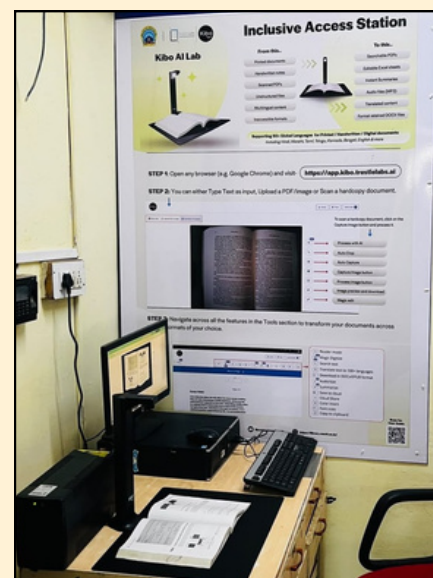

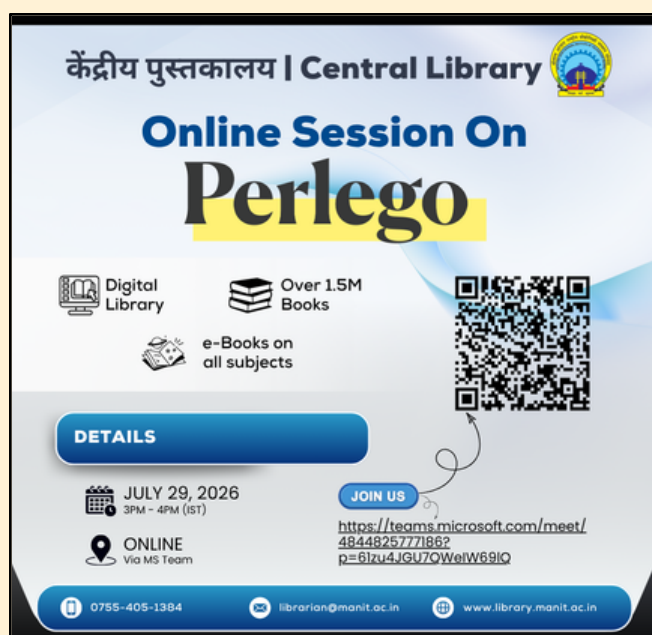

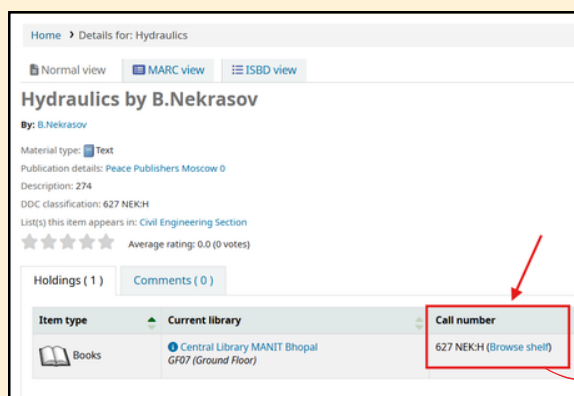

One-Day Seminar on National Librarians' Day 2026



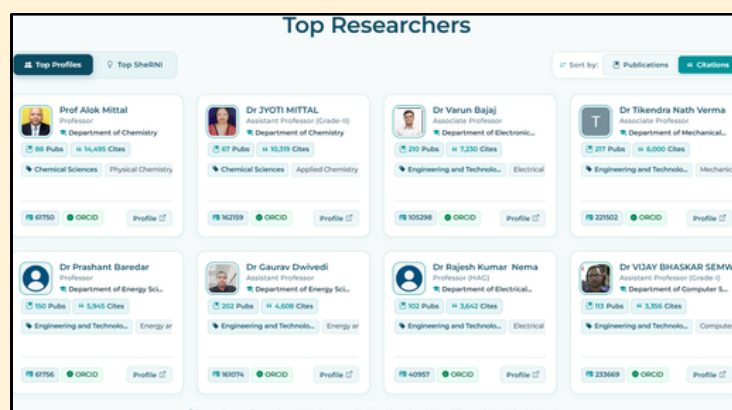
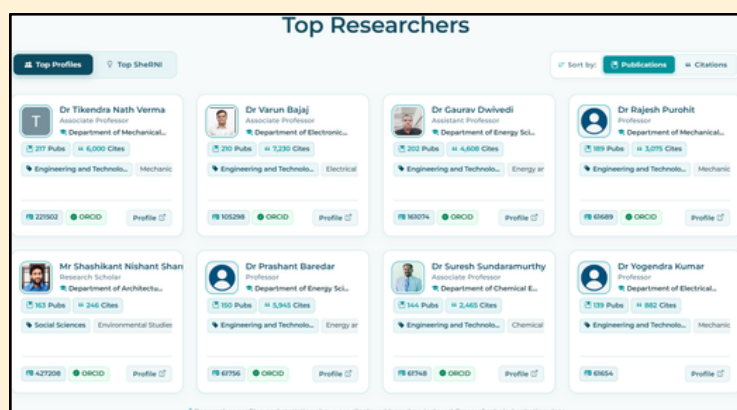
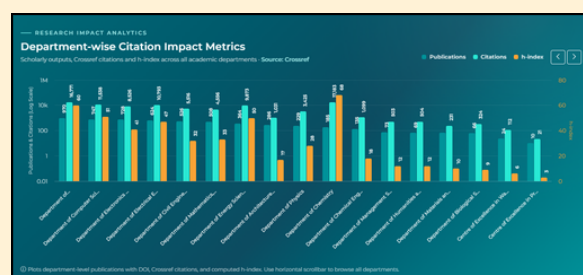
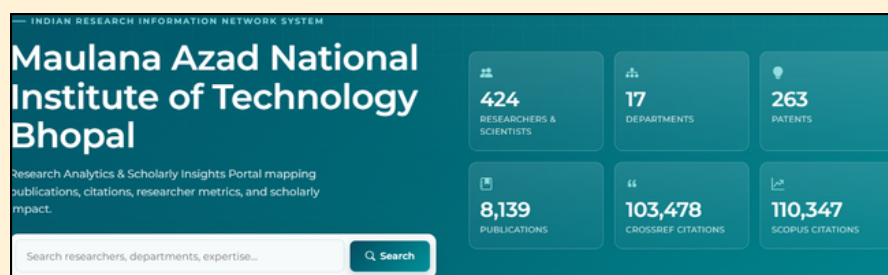

Library Statistics

The Central Library presents the bi-monthly statistical data on visitors and circulation of library materials. The following is highlighted for the months of July and August 2026:

The Central Library was visited by 3962 and 4565 visitors during the months of July and August, a total of 8527 in both months. The library has 1291 and 1952 visitors, respectively, from IIIT Bhopal during the same period (a total of 3243). On average, 158 students visited the library on a daily basis (for MANIT), and 45 students visited from IIIT Bhopal in the year 2026 (a total of 203 total students daily).



During July and August, the Central Library issued 2145 and 708 books, a total of 2853; returned 416 and 230 books, a total of 646; and renewed 31 and 27, a total of 58, respectively. On an average, during the year 2026, a total of 44 books were issued, 35 books were returned and 5 books were renewed on a daily basis.

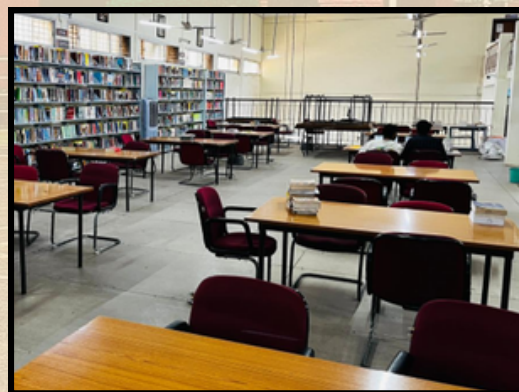
