The Central Library is happy to announce the integration of some of the additional Library Services to enhance the support system:

- **Turnitin**: is a plagiarism detection software that checks submitted documents against a vast database to identify similarities with other texts. You may send a request to library-rs@staff.manit.ac.in to create an account.
- **DrillBit**: A global checker that uses the most advanced technology to catch the most sophisticated forms of plagiarism. You may send a request to library-rs@staff.manit.ac.in to create an account.
- **Shodhganga**: is a reservoir that provides a platform for research scholars to deposit their PhD theses and make them available to the entire scholarly community in open access. For more details you may send an email to library-rs@staff.manit.ac.in

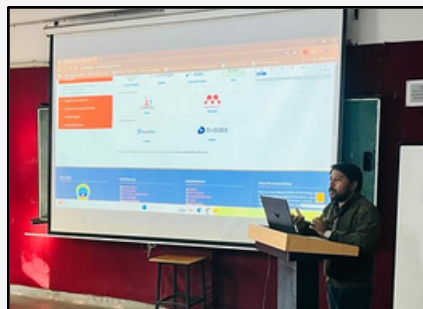




Connect with the Scholars

Online Demo Session: AccessEngineering

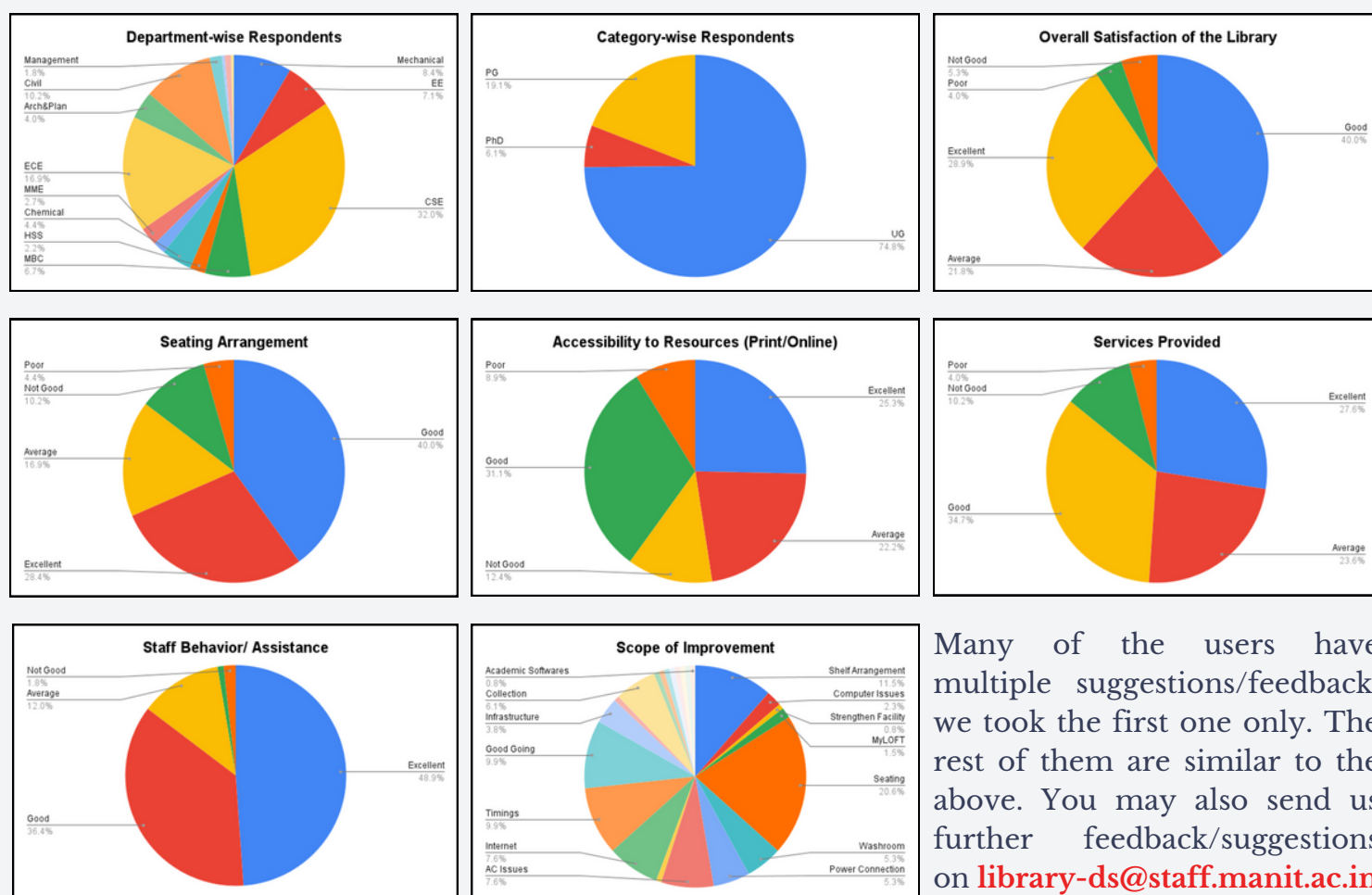

राष्ट्रीय पुस्तकालय सप्ताह के उपलक्ष्य में अखिल भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान संस्थान (AIIMS) भोपाल के डॉ. ए. पी. जे. अब्दुल कलाम पुस्तकालय (केंद्रीय पुस्तकालय) द्वारा दिनांक 15.11.2025 को "Library 360°: Tools, Tech, and Transformation" विषय पर एक दिवसीय कार्यशाला का सफलतापूर्वक आयोजन किया गया।



मैनिट भोपाल में राष्ट्रीय कर्मयोगी कार्यक्रम



मौलाना आज़ाद नेशनल इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ़ टेक्नोलॉजी भोपाल ने भारत सरकार की मशहूर राष्ट्रीय कर्मयोगी जन सेवा पहल के तहत अपनी फैकल्टी और स्टाफ मेंबर्स के लिए एक दिन का राष्ट्रीय कर्मयोगी प्रोग्राम सफलतापूर्वक ऑर्गनाइज़ किया। इस प्रोग्राम के तहत 10 और 12 दिसंबर, 2025 को 25-25 पार्टिसिपेंट्स के दो बैच को ट्रेनिंग दी।

राष्ट्रीय कर्मयोगी ट्रेनिंग प्रोग्राम (एक दिन) का फोकस सेंट्रल गवर्नमेंट के कर्मचारियों की पब्लिक सर्विस के प्रति सोच को बदलने पर है। इस प्रोग्राम का मकसद सरकारी कर्मचारियों में सेवा भाव - यानी सेवा और जवाबदेही की एक मज़बूत भावना पैदा करना है, जिससे वे ज़्यादा नागरिक केंद्रित बनें। राष्ट्रीय कर्मयोगी जन सेवा प्रोग्राम सभी सेंट्रल गवर्नमेंट कर्मचारियों में राष्ट्रीय कर्मयोगी मोमेंट्स के तौर पर गवर्नेंस में बेहतरीन कल्चर को बढ़ावा देने के लिए डेवलपमेंट, लीडरशिप ट्रेनिंग, व्यवहार में बदलाव के लिए है।

सेशन की शुरुआत पेडगॉग ऐप पर एक इंटरैक्टिव सर्वे से हुई, जिससे पार्टिसिपेंट्स को काम के बारे में अपनी सोच पर सोचने का मौका मिला। रामायण की कहानियों, मोटिवेशनल किस्सों और कर्मयोगी और पारंपरिक तरीकों की तुलना के ज़रिए, पार्टिसिपेंट्स ने यह पता लगाया कि नज़रिया बदलने से कैसे ज़्यादा पॉजिटिविटी और प्रोडक्टिविटी आ सकती है। 1.5 घंटे के चार मॉड्यूल में बने इस प्रोग्राम ने सोच-समझकर बातचीत करने, टीमवर्क करने और मिलकर प्रॉब्लम सॉल्व करने को बढ़ावा दिया। ऑफिसर्स को उनके अंदर की काबिलियत याद दिलाई गई और उन्हें एक प्रोएक्टिव तरीका अपनाने के लिए प्रेरित किया गया, जो “काम हो गया” वाली सोच से आगे बढ़कर समाधान, ज़िम्मेदारी और देश की तरक्की के लिए कमिटमेंट पर फोकस करता है। पार्टिसिपेंट्स को देश बनाने में अपनी भूमिका के बारे में कीमती जानकारी मिली।

मैनिट के बाकी सभी फैकल्टी और स्टाफ मेंबर्स के लिए भी ऐसे ही प्रोग्राम किए जाएंगे। मैनिट भोपाल के डॉ. वेंकट राव पोकुरी, डॉ. भरत मोढेरा, डॉ. अमित भगत और डॉ. भोलानाथ रॉय इस ट्रेनिंग के मास्टर ट्रेनर रहे।





Rashtriya Karmayogi Programme at MANIT Bhopal

Maulana Azad National Institute of Technology Bhopal (MANIT Bhopal) successfully organised a one-day Rashtriya Karmayogi Programme under the prestigious Rashtriya Karmayogi Jan Seva initiative by the Government of India for its faculty and staff members. Two batches of 25 participants each are trained under this programme on 10th and 12th December, 2025.

The Rashtriya Karmayogi Training programme focuses on transforming the mindset of Central Government employees towards public service. The objective of this programme is to instil Sewa Bhav - a strong sense of service and accountability among government employees, making them more citizen-centric. The Rashtriya Karmayogi Jan Seva programme is for development, leadership training, and behavioural change to foster a culture of excellence in governance as Rashtriya Karmayogi moments in all central government employees.

The session began with an interactive survey on the Pedgog App, allowing participants to reflect on their perception of work. Through stories from the Ramayana, motivational anecdotes, and comparisons of Karmayogi and conventional approaches, participants explored how shifting perspectives can lead to greater positivity and productivity. Structured into four modules of 1.5 hours each, the programme encouraged reflective discussions, teamwork, and collaborative problem-solving. Officers were reminded of their inner potential and inspired to adopt a proactive approach, moving beyond a "job-done" mindset to one focused on solutions, responsibility, and a commitment to national progress. Participants gained valuable insights into their roles in nation building.

Similar programmes will be conducted for all remaining faculty and staff members of MANIT. Dr. Venkata Rao Pokuri, Dr. Bharat Modhera, Dr. Amit Bhagat and Dr. Bholanath Roy from MANIT Bhopal are the Master Trainers of this training programme.

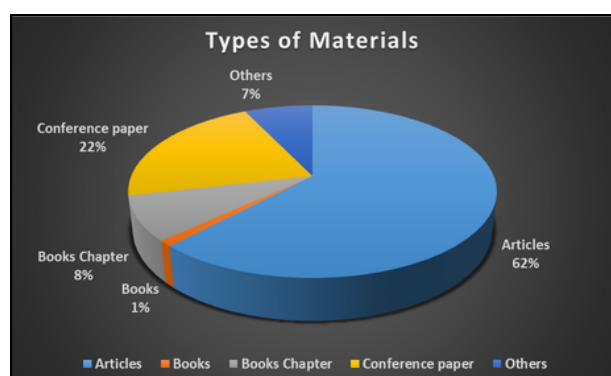
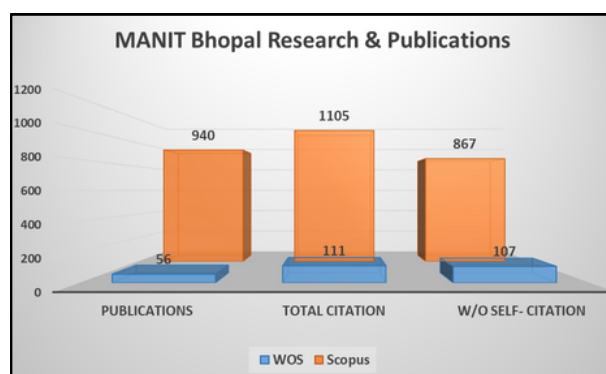

Research & Publications at MANIT Bhopal

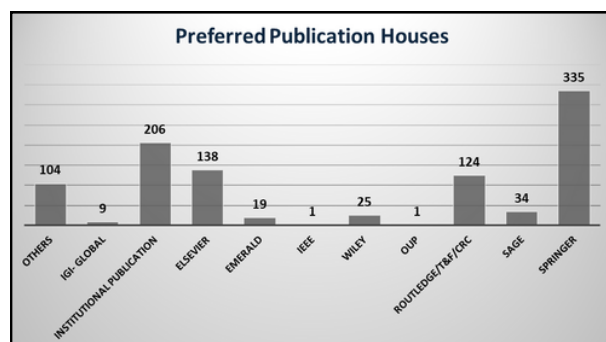


The MANIT Bhopal's growth rate is steadfast in terms of research and publications. A total of 132 papers has been published by the MANIT Bhopal community from **November to December 2025**. This brings the total number of publications to 996 for the current year. The citations received across the platforms are 1216 (from Scopus and Web of Science), and 974 (from Scopus and Web of Science) without self-citation have been received during 2025.



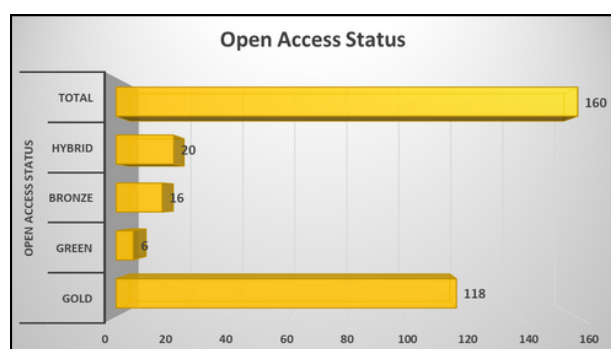
A total of 617 articles (62%), 11 books, 83 book chapters, 214 (21%) conference papers, and 71 other materials were published out of 996 publications in 2025.

Springer was the most preferred publication house, with 335 (more than 34%) publications, followed by various institute/society/university houses with 206 (21%), Elsevier with 138 (14%), Routledge/CRC/Taylor and Francis with 124 (12%), respectively, out of 996 total publications.

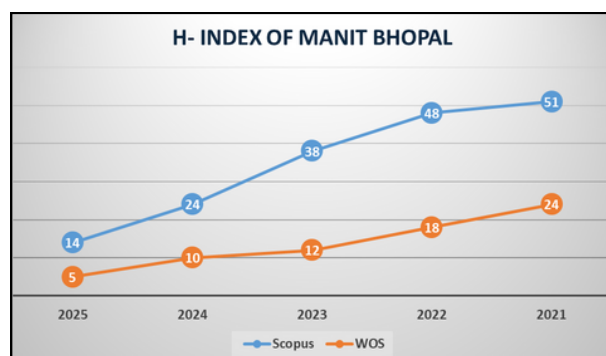


Apart from that, Sage, Wiley, Emerald, IEEE, Nature, OUP, IGI-Global, De-Gruyter, World Scientific and other publication houses were there.

A total of 160 (16%) materials were published as open access out of 996 total publications. Out of which 118 (74%) were published as gold open access, followed by 6 as Green, 16 as Bronze, and 20 as Hybrid, was in open access nature.



The h-index graph has exhibited consistent growth over the past five years, from 2021 to 2025, in both the database, Scopus & Web of Science respectively.

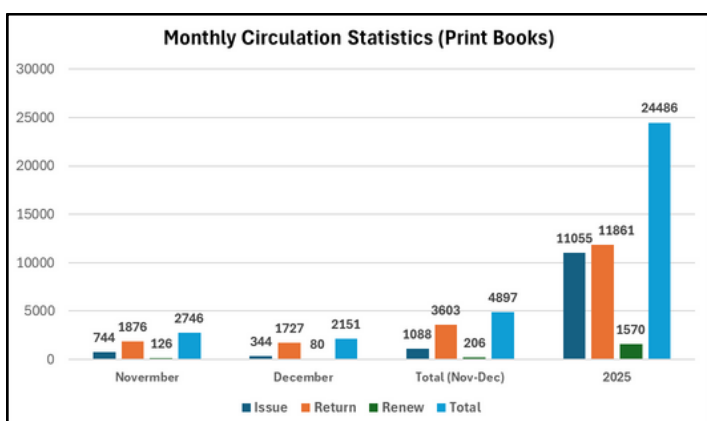
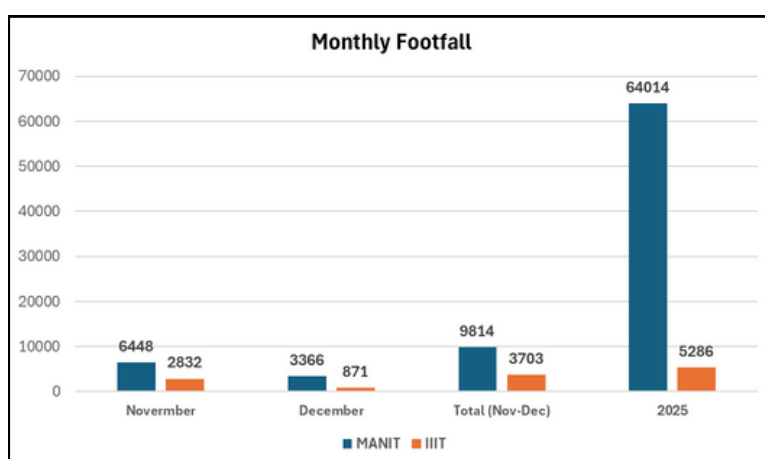


Library Statistics

The Central Library is evolving with an ample growth rate. Based on the statistical data points, the following can be highlighted as:

The Central Library was visited by 6448 and 3366 visitors during the months of November and December, a total of 9814 in both months. We also have 2832 and 871 visitors, respectively, from IIIT Bhopal during the same period (a total of 3703). With this the 2025 data grew to 64014 in total

for MANIT Bhopal and 5286 for IIIT Bhopal. On average, 216 students have visited the library on a daily basis (for MANIT), and 18 students visited from IIIT Bhopal, respectively in the year 2025.



During November and December, the Central Library issued 744 and 344 books, a total of 1088; returned 1876 and 1727 books, a total of 3603; and renewed 126 and 80, a total of 206, respectively. With this, the total circulation transaction number rose to 11055 (for issue), 11861 (for return), and 1570 (for renew) in the year 2025. On an average, during the year 2025, a total of 45 books were issued, 49 books were returned and 6 books were renewed on a daily basis.
