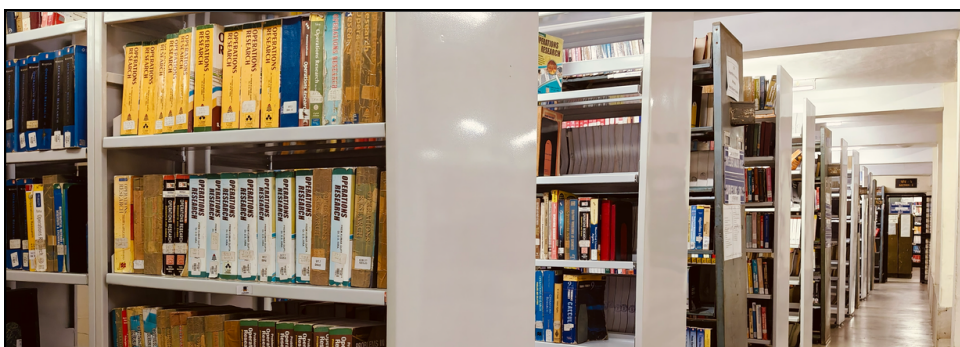
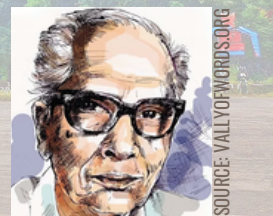

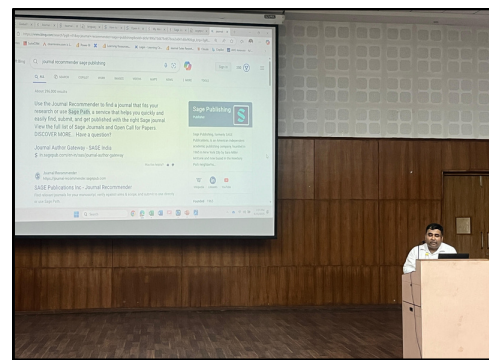

QR Code Based Entry/Exit System



The Central Library is now fully live on the QR code based entry/ exit system. Here are the steps you need to comply with:

- Visit the following link for mandatory one time registration via the SSO login portal. You can register in advance to avoid the rush while visiting the library.

- Once you are registered, you only need to scan the QR code each time (both for entry and exit) available at the library security desk, near the library entrance gate.

4 Enter some more details to complete mandatory one time registration.

5 After completing the registration, scan the QR for entry/ exit to the library each time.

6 You will be able to track your library footprints while logged in the portal.

Note: Next time onwards, scan the QR only for entry/ exit.

Please note:

- All members are requested to make entry/ exit via scanning the QR code compulsorily.
- During the testing phase, you need to make an entry both digitally and in the print register, which will continue for one week.
- On Tuesday, 29th April, we will test a completely QR based entry/ exit for the full day.
- All the library members of all categories (faculty/ staff/ students) are requested to make entry/ exit via the QR code.

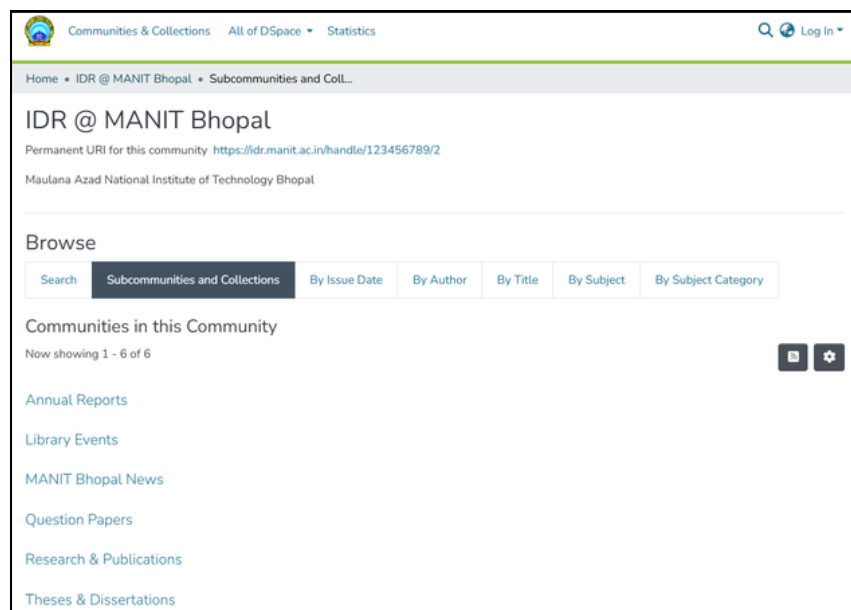

Annual Reports, Library Events, MANIT

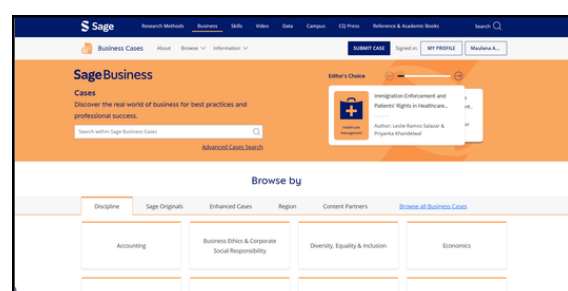

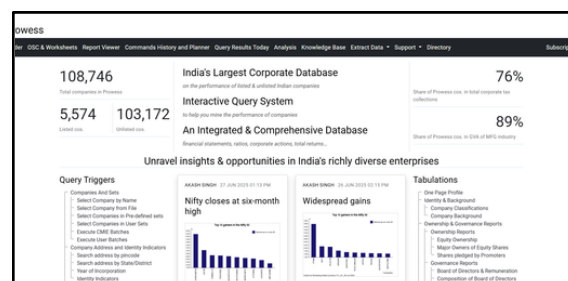

CMIE Prowess- The Prowess database consists of the financial performance of 108,000 Indian companies. The database contains information on all companies traded on the NSE and BSE, thousands of unlisted public limited companies, and hundreds of private limited companies. It covers the financial statements, interim results, annual reports, market capitalization, stock price & capital changes, business segments and products, CapEx and M&A, ownership structure and governance indicators, and indices value. There are over 1,500 data fields per company and an additional 1,400 data fields specifically for banking and NBFC companies, and it provides time-series data back to the year 1989.

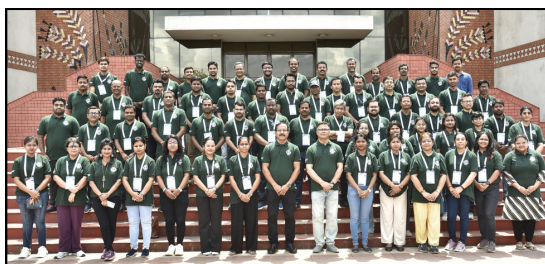

Professional Development – Workshop at IIMC

Mr. Wasim Rahaman, Assistant Librarian of MANIT Bhopal was nominated by the Central Library to attend the **National Workshop on Data Carpentry and AI/ML Tools for Libraries** organized by the **B. C. Roy Memorial Library, Indian Institute of Management Calcutta** from 19/05/2025 to 23/05/2025. In the said five-day workshop various research tools were first demonstrated by the resource persons (Dr. Narayan Chandra Ghosh of IIM Calcutta, Prof. Partha Sarathi Mukhopadhyay and Dr. Ujjal Marjit of Kalyani University) and then practiced hand-on by the participants in a well-equipped and hi-tech computer lab of the institute.



Professional Development – Conference at MRIIRS

Dr. Venkata Rao Pokuri, Librarian & Head, MANIT Bhopal attended a two-day **International Conference on Innovation and Digital Transformation in Academic Libraries**, organised by **Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies, Faridabad** on 27-28 May 2025 at Faridabad. Dr Rao was a Resource Person during one of the Sessions. The two-day Conference was attended by over 150 delegates from India and abroad.



Session – Open Access Journals at MANIT Bhopal

Dr. Venkata Rao Pokuri, Librarian & Head, Central Library, MANIT Bhopal conducted a session on **Navigating Digital Repositories and Open Access Journals** on 7th May 2025 at MANIT Bhopal. This session was a part of ten-day **ICSSR-sponsored Research Methodology Workshop on Navigating Traditional and Contemporary Research Methods for Humanities and Social Sciences within the Indian Knowledge System**, organised from 28th April to 7th May 2025 at MANIT Bhopal. The programme was attended by 40 Research Scholars and Faculty members from various institutions across the country.

During his presentation, Dr Rao discussed various aspects of navigating digital repositories and highlighted and demonstrated various digital repositories that would be of most useful to the researchers. He also dwelled upon open access and current trends in publishing in open access journals.

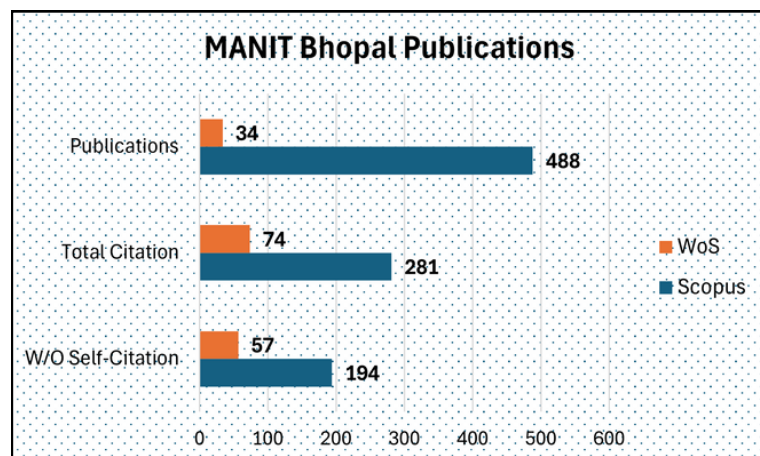

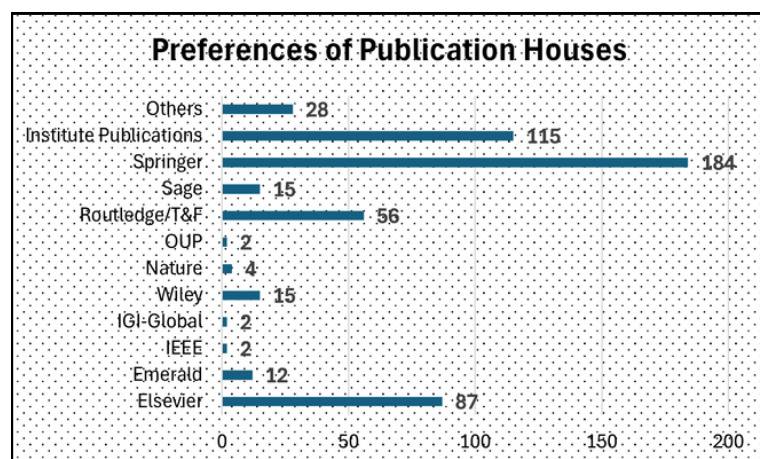
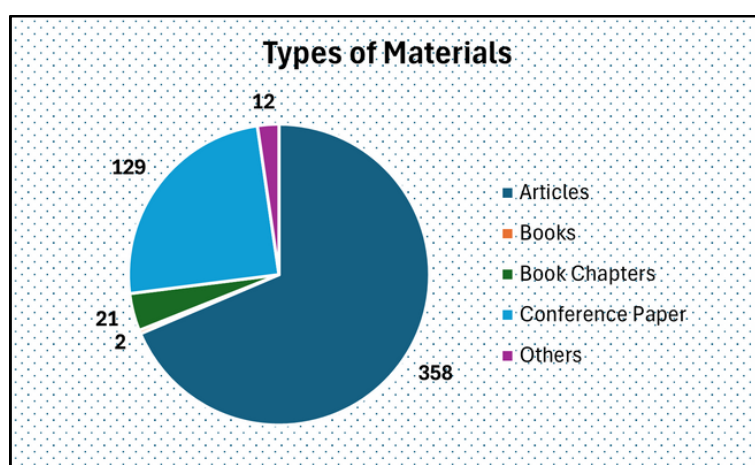
Research & Publications @ MANIT Bhopal



The MANIT Bhopal's growth rate is on steadfast in terms of research and publications. A total of 198 papers has been published by the MANIT Bhopal community during May to June 2025. With this, the total number of publications stood at 522 during the current year. The citations received across the platforms are 281 (from Scopus) and 74 (from Web of Science), and 194 (from Scopus) and 57 (from Web of Science) without self-citation have been received during 2025.

A total of 358 articles (69%), 2 books, 21 book chapters, 129 (25%) conference papers, and 12 other materials were published out of 522 publications in 2025.

Springer was the most preferred publication house with 184 (more than 35%) publications, followed by various institute/society/university houses with 115 (22%), Elsevier with 87 (17%) Routledge/CRC/Taylor and Francis with 56 (11%) respectively out of 522 total publications. Apart from that Sage, Wiley, Emerald, IEEE,



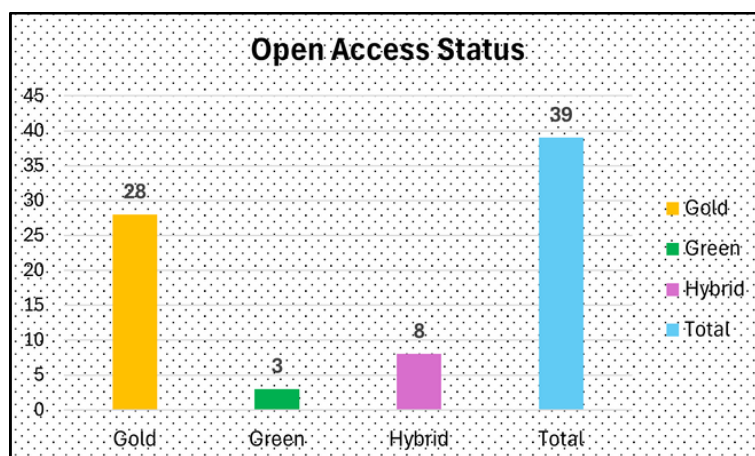
Nature, OUP, IGI-Global and other publication houses were there.

A total of 39 (7%) materials were published as open access out of 522 total publications. Out of which 28 (72%) were published as gold open access, followed by 3 Green and 8 Hybrid was in open access nature.

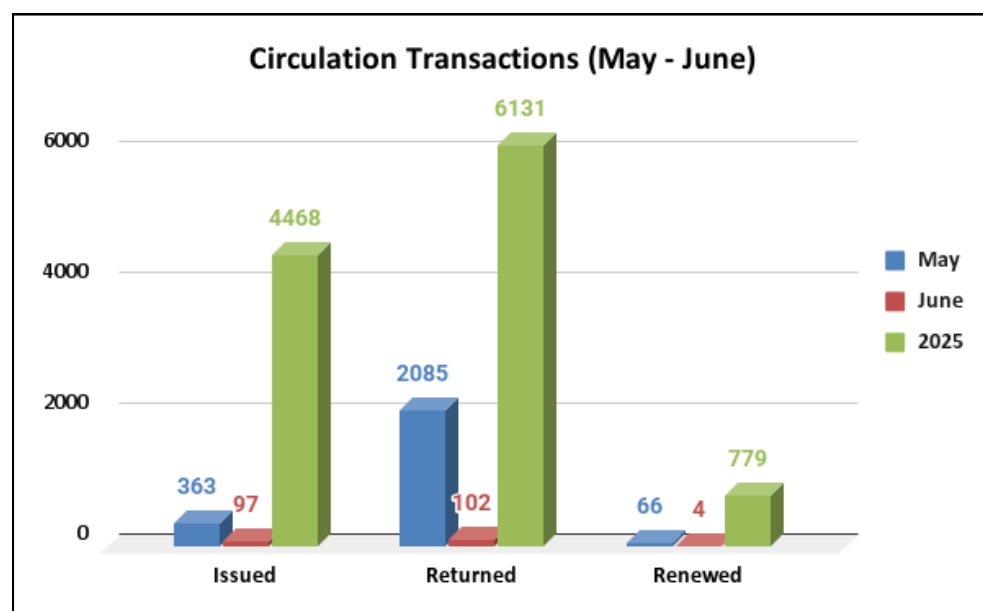
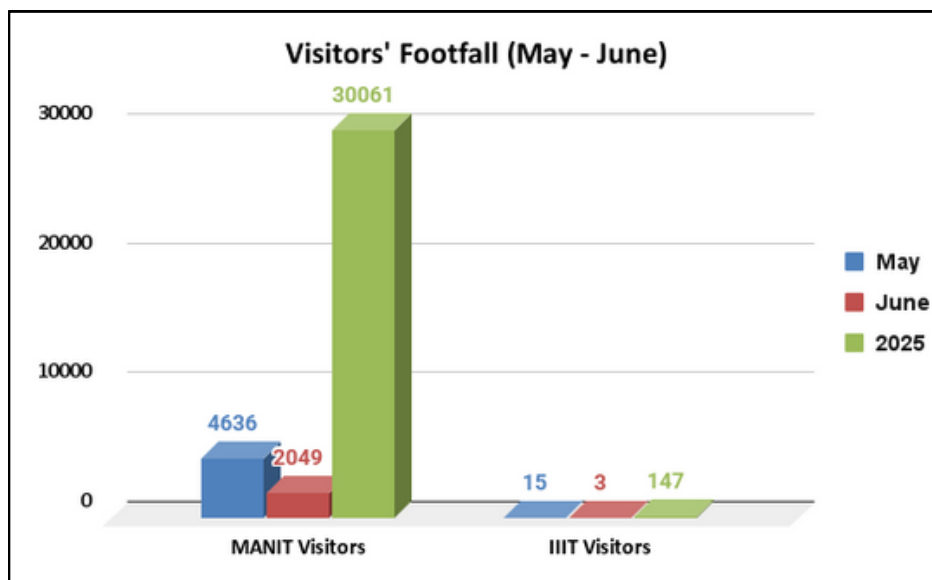


Library Statistics



The Central Library is evolving with an ample growth rate. Based on the statistical data points, the followings can be highlighted as:

The Central Library was visited by 4636, and 2049 visitors during the month of May and June, a total of 6685. We also have 15 and 3 visitors respectively from IIIT Bhopal during the same period. With this the 2025 footfall data grown to 30061 in total for MANIT Bhopal and 147 for IIIT Bhopal.



The Central Library issued 363, and 97 books, a total of 460, returned 2085, and 102 books, a total of 2187, and renewed 66, and 4, a total of 70 in the month of May and June respectively. With this the total circulation transaction number rose to 4468 (for issue), 6131 (for return), and 779 (for renew) in 2025. On an average, in 2025 36 books were issued, 50 books were returned and 6 books were renewed on a daily basis.
